Filling out **your** report form!

Filling out your reports online is the easiest and most efficient way to submit reports, but can sometimes become a bit confusing, so here a few tips for filling it out!

ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS

Simply list whether your activity was a service, by just filling out this section, a fundraiser, raising money for an organization, or K-Family joint project, doing a project with any member of our K-Family. Then tell the title of the project, followed by how many members attended, and lastly with a rating from 5 (being good) and 1 (being poor).

MEETING INFORMATION

The first part of this section is the average percentage of members attending your meetings, followed by how many meetings your club has held. State whether a faculty advisor was present, and if the Kiwanis advisor was present, and lastly; list the number of Kiwanis meetings your members attended!

SPEAKER AND PROGRAMS

On this section, you simply list the speaker, the date and the subject. This should be for anyone who came to your meeting and talks about something relating to service.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS/ OFFICER MEETINGS

This section is specifically for your officer meetings, and what they did throughout the meeting. This follows the same procedure for the club meeting section.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

This is where you list all of the public relations your clubs has done this month. This section covers everything from newspapers, to handouts, to newsletters and to posters. One thing you must have with this is a proof, which is the actual copy or a picture of the copy.

LTG CONTACT

In this section, clubs talk about what kind of contact they have had with their Lieutenant Governor, which is highly important.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

This is any comments you have concerning your **AWESOME** service month!!

As a Statistical Secretary, it is your job to keep a majority of the records, and most importantly; submit club monthly reports! Here are a few general responsibilities:

RESPONSIBILITIES

Attend all club board meetings, ensure all club reports are submitted on time, attend Regional Training Conferences during the term in office, attend a majority of the regular club meetings and ensure the annual Club Achievement Report is submitted.

REASONS TO SUBMIT CLUB MONTHLY REPORTS

The whole reasons there is a

District Board, is to help relate the club members to the District as a whole, and club monthly reports are an awesome way to form this bond. With the District's help, a club can receive answers to just about any questions that they have submitted on their form! Another important act that a monthly report does is track your clubs progress throughout the year, and show your club what they need to work on.

REPORT DUE DATES

March Report = April 10th
April Report = May 10th
May Report = June 10th
Summer = September 10th

September report = October 10th
October Report = November 10th
November Report = December 10th
December Report = January 10th
January Report = February 10th
February Report = March 10th

HOW DO I SEND THESE?

Clubs can either submit their monthly report online at www.ikeyclub.org, or the paper form, which is available online. If clubs submit the paper form, copies must be sent to three people: The District Administrator, myself and your Division's Lieutenant Governor.
