

There are so many awards you and/or your club can apply for and potentially earn! Use this resource as a reduced version of the Awards Booklet that highlights all the awards, a brief description, and their deadline.

Individual Awards

- **Distinguished President** (33 points required)
- **Distinguished Vice President** (20 points required)
- **Distinguished Secretary** (20 points required)
- **Distinguished Statistical Secretary** (20 points required)
- **Distinguished Treasurer** (20 points required)
- **Distinguished Editor** (20 points required)
- **Distinguished Senior Member** (12 points required)
- **Distinguished Junior Member** (12 points required)
- **Distinguished Sophomore Member** (12 points required)
- **Distinguished Freshman Member** (11 points required)
- **100 Hour Honor**
 - For any member earning 100 service hours

Club Awards

- **Preferred Charities Partnership Award**
 - For clubs with three outstanding service projects with at least three of Key Club International's service partners
- **Kiwanis Family Relations**
 - For clubs demonstrating a strong relationship with their sponsoring Kiwanis club and any other clubs of the Kiwanis family
- **Connect the K's**
 - For clubs able to connect with at least three other branches of the Kiwanis Family during Connect the K's Day of Key Club Week
- **Interclub Award**
 - For clubs with at least 4 interclub events (a meeting, project, or event by 2 or more branches of the Kiwanis family)

Club Awards continued

- **Public Relations** (225 points required)
 - For clubs with strong public relations in their school and community
- **Club Bulletin/Newsletter**
 - For clubs that create and distribute at least 7 different bulletins/newsletters
- **Technology Award**
 - For clubs that have created and maintained a website to keep their school and community informed about their club

 - For the top three clubs in the District with submitted articles and pictures to the Iolian
- **RIOT Award**
 - For clubs that submitted their Club Officer Roster by September 15th, 2023

- **Early Bird Dues Award**
 - For clubs that submitted their dues on or before November 1st, 2023

- An opportunity to compete with other Key Clubs for overall excellence in the areas of club, administration, membership growth, leadership development, Kiwanis-family involvement, and most importantly, club service.
